Undercover Lessons to Keep Christian Nationalism Out of California Schools

Christian nationalists are infiltrating religion into public schools nationwide. Learn how to recognize signs that this may be happening in your local schools, and how you can help lobby your representatives in Sacramento to support a bill to keep religion out of public schools throughout California.

Our speaker, Mickey Dollens, has seen religious infiltration first hand as an Oklahoma state Representative. You'll hear his recent experience going undercover at a school chaplain strategy meeting, where he uncovered the detailed playbook Christian nationalists are using to infiltrate public education. According to him, "It's a wild story."

To keep California public schools secular, Mickey and the FFRF Action Fund have developed a Secular Student Bill of Rights, a model law which, if enacted in California and other states, would protect students' freedom of conscience and strengthen state-church separation in public schools. Our Bay Area legislators should be willing to carry this bill in Sacramento, but it's up to you to get them engaged.

Mickey will share practical strategies for lobbying your elected officials, influencing policy, and advocating effectively for secular values, as well as provide insider tips for crafting persuasive messages, getting lawmakers to actually pay attention, and building grassroots momentum to drive real change.
